YARN

Rowan Kid Classic and Kidsilk Haze

(photographed in following shades, to view a full current yarn range visit www.knitrowan.com)

A Classic Glacier 822

6 6 6 7 7 x 50gm

B Haze Heavenly 592

4 4 4 5 5 x 25gm

NEEDLES

1 pair 5mm (no 6) (US 8) needles

1 pair 5½mm (no 5) (US 9) needles

1 pair 6mm (no 4) (US 10) needles

BUTTONS – 2

TENSION

16 sts and 20 rows to 10 cm measured over stocking stitch pattern using 6mm (US 10) needles and yarn A and yarn B HELD TOGETHER.

BACK

Cast on 76 (80: 84: 88: 92) sts using 5½mm (US 9) needles and yarn A and yarn B HELD TOGETHER.

Row 1 (RS): K1, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 3 sts, P2, K1.

Row 2: P1, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 3 sts, K2, P1.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 8 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 6mm (US 10) needles.

Beg with a K row, cont in st st as folls:

Work 2 rows.

Next row (dec) (RS): K2, K2tog, K to last 4 sts, K2tog tbl, K2.

Working all decreases as set by last row, dec 1 st at each end of every foll 6th row until 68 (72: 76: 80: 84) sts rem.

Work 13 rows, ending with a WS row.

Next row (inc) (RS): K2, M1, K to last 2 sts, M1, K2.

Working all increases as set by last row, inc 1 st at each end of every foll 8th row until there are 76 (80: 84: 88: 92) sts.

Cont straight until back measures 37 (38: 38: 39: 39) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape armholes

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

68 (72: 76: 80: 84) sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 5 (5: 7: 7: 9) rows, then on foll 0 (1: 1: 2: 2) alt rows, then on foll 4th row.

56 (58: 58: 60: 60) sts.

Cont straight until armhole measures 22 (22: 23: 23: 24) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulders and back neck

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

48 (50: 50: 52: 52) sts.

Next row (RS): Cast off 4 sts, K until there are 7 sts on right needle and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next row.

Cast off rem 3 sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarns to rem sts, cast off centre 26 (28: 28: 30: 30) sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

FRONT

Work as given for back until 10 (10: 10: 12: 12) rows less have been worked than on back to start of shoulder shaping, ending with a WS row.

Shape neck

Next row (RS): K17 (17: 17: 18: 18) and turn, leaving rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

Dec 1 st at neck edge of next 4 rows, then on foll 2 (2: 2: 3: 3) alt rows.

11 sts.

Work 1 row, ending with a WS row.

Shape shoulder

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next and foll alt row.

Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 3 sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarns to rem sts, cast off centre 22 (24: 24: 24: 24) sts, K to end.

Complete to match first side, reversing shapings.

SLEEVES (both alike)

Cast on 48 (48: 48: 50: 50) sts using 5½mm (US 9) needles and yarn A and yarn B HELD TOGETHER.

Row 1 (RS): P1 (1: 1: 2: 2), K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 1 (1: 1: 2: 2) sts, P1 (1: 1: 2: 2).

Row 2: K1 (1: 1: 2: 2), P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last 1 (1: 1: 2: 2) sts, K1 (1: 1: 2: 2).

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 18 rows, ending with a WS row.

Change to 6mm (US 10) needles.

Beg with a K row, cont in st st as folls:

Work 4 rows.

Next row (inc) (RS): K2, M1, K to last 2 sts, M1, K2.

Working all increases as set by last row, inc 1 st at each end of every foll 20th (20th: 16th: 20th: 16th) row to 54 (54: 54: 58: 56) sts, then on every foll 18th (18th: 14th: -: 14th) row until there are 56 (56: 58: -: 60) sts.

Cont straight until sleeve measures 46 (46: 47: 47: 47) cm, ending with a WS row.

Shape top

Cast off 4 sts at beg of next 2 rows.

48 (48: 50: 50: 52) sts.

Dec 1 st at each end of next 3 rows, then on foll alt row, then on every foll 4th row until 32 (32: 34: 34: 36) sts rem.

Work 1 row, ending with a WS row.

Dec 1 st at each end of next and every foll alt row to 28 sts, then on foll 5 rows, ending with a WS row.

Cast off rem 18 sts.

MAKING UP

Press.

Join both shoulder seams using back stitch, or mattress stitch if preferred.

Collar

Cast on 90 (98: 98: 106: 106) sts using 5mm (US 8) needles and yarn A and yarn B HELD TOGETHER.

Row 1 (RS): K2, (P1, K1) 3 times, P2, *K2, P2, rep from * to last

8 sts, (K1, P1) 3 times, K2.

Row 2: (K1, P1) 4 times, K2, *P2, K2, rep from * to last 8 sts, (P1, K1) 4 times.

These 2 rows form rib.

Work in rib for a further 10 rows.

Change to 6mm (US 10) needles.

Work 4 rows, ending with a WS row.

Row 17 (RS): Rib 18, M1, rib 2, M1, rib 30 (34: 34: 38: 38), M1, rib 2, M1, rib to end. 94 (102: 102: 110: 110) sts.

Keeping rib correct, work 3 rows.

Row 21: Rib 19, M1, rib 2, M1, rib 32 (36: 36: 40: 40), M1, rib 2, M1, rib to end. 98 (106: 106: 114: 114) sts.

Keeping rib correct, work 3 rows.

Row 25: Rib 20, M1, rib 2, M1, rib 34 (38: 38: 42: 42), M1, rib 2, M1, rib to end. 102 (110: 110: 118: 118) sts.

Keeping rib correct, work 3 rows.


Row 29: Rib 21, M1, rib 2, M1, rib 36 (40: 40: 44: 44), M1, rib 2, M1, rib to end. 106 (114: 114: 122: 122) sts.

Keeping rib correct, work 3 rows.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Set in sleeves using the set-in method.

Overlap ends of collar for 8 sts and sew cast-on edge of collar to neck edge, positioning shaped sections at shoulder seams. Using photograph as a guide, attach buttons through both layers of collar.



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
