YARN			
BIG WOOL			
2 colour version			
A – Smokey 007	1	1	x 100 gm
B – Glum 056	2	3	x 100 gm

1 colour embroidered version			
A – White Hot 001	3	4	x 100 gm
Oddments of Kid Classic in Cherry Red 847 and Spruce 853			

NEEDLES
pair 10mm (no 000) (US15) needles

EXTRAS
leather/suede patches if required

TENSION
9 sts and 12.5 rows to 10cm over st st on 10mm needles before washing.

2 COLOUR VERSION
Cast on 35 [41] sts using A. Work 4 rows in g st. Change to B. Starting with a K row, work 23 [24] cm in st st, ending with RS facing for next row.

Divide for top of foot
Next row: K24 (28), turn, P13 [15], turn.

On these 13 [15] sts only and using A, work 22 [26] rows in st st, break yarn.

With RS facing and using B (and 11 [13] sts on needle), pick up and knit 11 [13] sts along side of centre panel extension, knit across 13 [15] sts from toe, 11 [13] sts along side of centre panel extension and K across rem 11 [13] sts on needle. 57 [67] sts.

Work 7 [8] cm in g st, ending with RS facing for next row.

Shape sole

Row 1: K1, * K2tog, K22 (27), K2tog * K3, work from * to * again, K1.

Row 2: K23 (28), K2tog, K3, K2tog, K to end.

Row 3: K1, * K2tog, K19 (24), K2tog * K3, work from * to * again, K1.

Row 4: K20 (25), K2tog, K3, K2tog, knit to end.

Row 5: K1, * K2tog, K16 (21), K2tog, * K3, work from * to * again, K1.

Row 6: K17 (22), K2tog, K3, K2tog, knit to end.

Row 7: K1, * K2tog, K13 (18), K2tog * K3, work from * to * again, K1.

Row 8: Cast off.

MAKING UP

Join leg and underfoot seam.

Machine wash at 50 degrees.

If slippers are to be worn rather than used as a decoration, sew a leather/suede patch to soles of boots.

1 COLOUR VERSION

Work as given for 2 colour version using A throughout.

MAKING UP

Join leg and underfoot seam. Using couching and lazy daisy stitch embroider boots as shown.

Machine wash at 50 degrees.

If required sew a leather/suede patch to soles of boots.

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
