

Crocheted Zebra Pattern

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Materials

When using Three Bears Yarn Affection 100% Aran cotton, the finished item measures approximately 38cm from toe to head.

2 balls of Pitch Black (B) and 1 ball of Pure White (W)

3mm hook

Wadding for stuffing the body

2 x 10mm Black Safety Eyes and 2 x 10mm Coloured Safety Eyes

Stitch Marker

Pins

Abbreviations

Ch – Chain

Dc – Double Crochet

Htr – Half Treble

Tr – Treble

Dtr – Double Treble

Inc – Increase (2 stitches worked into one)

Dec – Decrease (1 stitch worked into 2)

Notes

This pattern is written in English form, so for everyone in America (or anywhere else that uses the same pattern type) please read my dc as your sc's.

This pattern is worked in the round unless specified, without joining at each end of the row.

All stitches are worked into both loops of the stitches.

Place your stitch marker in the first stitch of each round to make it easier to keep track of your round number.

Head

Rnd 1: In B and working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: 2 dc into next st, 6 times. 12 sts

Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 18 sts

Rnd 4: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 24 sts

Rnd 5: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 30 sts

Rnd 6: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 36 sts

Rnd 7: [5 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 42 sts

Rnd 8: [6 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 48 sts

Rnds 9-12: 48 dc Change Yarn

Rnd 13: In W [6 dc, dec2tog] 6 times. 42 sts

Rnds 14-15: 42 dc. Change Yarn.

Rnd 16: In B [5 dc, dec2tog] 6 times. 36 sts

Rnds 17-18: 36 dc Change Yarn

Rnd 19: In W [4 dc, dec2tog] 6 times. 30 sts

Rnds 20-21: 30 dc. Change Yarn

Rnds 22-24: In B 30 dc. Change Yarn

Rnds 25-26: In W 30 dc.

Insert Black safety eyes between rows 14 and 15, approximately 13 sts apart.

Insert Coloured safety eyes between rows 24 and 25, approximately 6 sts apart.

Fill with stuffing.

Rnd 27: [3 dc, dec2tog] 6 times. 24 sts

Rnd 28: [2 dc, dec2tog] 6 times. 18 sts

Rnd 29: [1 dc, dec2tog] 6 times. 12 sts

Rnd 30: [dec2tog] 6 times. 6 sts

Fasten off and break yarn. Thread remaining yarn through the 6 sts and pull tight.



Ears (Make 2)

Rnd 1: In B and working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: 6 dc

Rnd 3: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 9 sts

Rnd 4: 9 dc

Rnd 5: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 12 sts

Rnd 6: 12 dc

Rnd 7: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 18 sts

Rnds 8-9: 18 dc

Fold in half at the bottom and sew onto head.



Mane (Make 2 black and 1 white)

Chain 22

Row 1: 2 tr into each st. 20 sts

Fasten off and break yarn. Sew together onto head between ears.

Body

Rnd 1: In B and working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: 2 dc into next st, 6 times. 12 sts

From here alternate colour from black to white every 3 rounds.

Rnds 3-4: 12 dc

Rnd 5: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 18 sts

Rnds 6-7: 18 dc

Rnd 8: [2 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 24 sts

Rnds 9-10: 24 dc

Rnds 11: [3 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 30 sts

Rnds 12-13: 30 dc



Rnd 14: [4 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 36 sts

Rnds 15-16: 36 dc

Rnd 17: [5 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 42 sts

Rnds 18-19: 42 dc

Rnd 20: [6 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 48 sts

Rnds 21-22: 48 dc

Rnd 23: [7 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 54 sts

Rnds 24-25: 54 dc

Rnd 26:[8 dc, 2 dc into next st] 6 times. 60 sts

Rnds 27-28: 60 dc. Fasten off.

Legs (Make 2)

Rnd 1: In B and working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: 2 dc into next st, 6 times. 12 sts

Rnds 3-11: 12 dc

Rnd 12: [2 dc, dec2tog] 3 times. Change Yarn. 9 sts

From here alternate colour from black to white every 3 rounds.

Rnds 13-48: In 9 dc. Fasten off.

Arms (Make 2)

Rnd 1: In B and working into magic ring, 6 dc.

Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc into next st] 3 times. 9 sts

Rnds 3-6: 9 dc. Change Yarn

From here alternate colour from black to white every 3 rounds.

Rnds 7-33: 9 dc. Fasten off.



To assemble, lightly fill the body with toy stuffing, sew up along the bottom, inserting the legs as you go, securing in place with the stitches. Embroider the pattern detail onto the body. Sew arms, and head onto the body.
